General Traffic Engineering Consultant Services

Response to Inquiries
Request for Expressions of Interest

1. **Inquiry:** In Subsection A1 EOI Submission Requirements of the RFEI, paragraph b. indicates "Unless otherwise noted, the Project Manager shall be a licensed Professional Engineer." Given the national specialized niche services for Traffic and Revenue (T&R) which includes planners and economists, in addition to engineers, this requirement will greatly limit the number of highly qualified individuals that can be proposed as Project Manager for this contract. Traditionally, including historically on this contract, services provided by the Traffic and Revenue Consultant, including Investment Grade T&R studies have not required the Project Manager to be a Professional Engineer nor does the T&R industry, rating agencies, or other financial institutions require specific licensures or certifications for the T&R expert. Would NJTA reconsider the need for a Professional Engineer licensing for the Project Manager so long as the team demonstrates in our organization chart a Professional Engineer(s) able to undertake any engineering related tasks?

Response: The requirement for the Project Manager to be a licensed Professional Engineer will be deleted. An Addendum will be issued.
