**Responses to Inquiries
Request for Expressions of Interest**

1. **Inquiry:** On page 8 of the RFEOI, Section 6 – Proposed Staff is requesting “when proposing the same staff in multiple EOIs”, the qualified firm must disclose a statement. This typically refers to the Certification of Staff Availability form. Are we to include the form here in this section, or should the consultant provide a statement that we are not utilizing the same staff, in addition to the form?

Response: If the Qualified Firm is not proposing the same staff in multiple EOIs, an additional statement pertaining to the referenced section is not required. The Certification of Staff Availability form is to be included in the submission regardless of whether the Qualified Firm is proposing staff for more than one Authority project.

2. **Inquiry:** There are two similar forms, one is the “Recent Authority Project Experience Form” and the other is the “Recent Project Experience Form”. Both are extremely similar; however the “Recent Project Experience” form request the project number, and not the OPS number. Is it okay to provide the OPS No. in the Project No. column?

Response: Please reference the Contract No. and OPS No.

3. **Inquiry:** Is there an estimate of construction cost for the project?

Response: An estimated construction cost is provided in the RFEOI on page 14.

4. **Inquiry:** Is a QCxP certification from the University of Wisconsin (which requires passing a test that includes an overview of the commissioning process and ASHRAE Guidelines) and with more than 30 years of experience in commissioning, be considered equivalent to the ASHRAE Certified Commissioning Professional (BCxP)?

Response: The Qualified Commissioning Process Provider certificate will be considered in the evaluation of proposed staff members.
